Directions from Montpelier, Vermont to Worcester, VT

From MONTPELIER to Worcester (about 15 minutes)

--- From I89 Take exit 8 into Montpelier. Go straight (through 3 traffic lights) to Rte 12 (Main Street.) Turn left onto Rte 12N (Main Street.)

Go straight for about 3 or 4 blocks until you come to a traffic rotary. (There is a Masonic Hall on the corner) Stay left on the rotary, following Rte 12N onto Spring Street. At the intersection of Spring Street and Elm Street (one block), turn right onto Rte 12N (Elm Street.) Stay on Rte 12N straight into Worcester (about 9 miles.)

In Worcester go straight until you see the Worcester Town Hall on the corner of Rte 12 and Calais Road. Turn onto the Calais Road. (The Calais Road begins there, so there's only one way to go.)

On the Calais Road you will see the Doty Memorial School on your left. Go across the bridge. Stay on the pavement. You will pass an orange house with burgundy trim on your right. About 1/4 mile from the orange house there is a bend in the road on the right. Slow down. Just past the bend, on the right hand side, is the bottom of two long, steep driveways. Our driveway is the one that is on the right. It is a very sharp, right hand turn.

It is a long, steep driveway. You will see a large "Jamieson" sign on the right. Keep going straight up and bear left.

You will see a large, tan house and a large pond on your right. There is plenty of parking.

(On the Calais Road, if you come to the "Pratt Road" on the left, you have gone too far. Turn around and you will see the driveway.)
